Preparation

The length of the article should be indicated in the number of words.

Reviews should be submitted in a format that is accessible to all reviewers.

Manuscript submissions. *SSLA* welcomes unsolicited articles, including replication studies; State of the Art articles, review articles, articles in thematic issues, responses, Point and Counterpoint articles, and book reviews are commissioned by the editors. Manuscripts should not have been published previously or be under consideration for publication elsewhere in any form. In addition, *SSLA* will consider only one submission per author per volume.

Manuscripts undergo a two-tier evaluation process. First, they are read by an in-house committee. If topic and scope are deemed appropriate, they are then sent out for blind review to at least three readers selected from the Editorial Board, Advisory Committee, and other experts in the field. The names of all readers consulted will be listed in the final issue of each volume. A publication decision is usually made within four months of submission (10 to 20 percent of manuscripts submitted are accepted for publication). **All manuscripts must be submitted electronically to ssla@indiana.edu.** Upon acceptance for external review, authors are then asked to submit one blinded hardcopy and one blinded electronic copy of the manuscript in which all references to the author(s) and their work have been removed.

- Insufficient originality
- Serious Scientific Flaws
- Absence of a message that is important to the target audience
- Questionnaire surveys with low response rates
- Articles that are simply descriptive with little attempt at evaluation

If you are sending a revised manuscript back to the journal, you should include a detailed point-by-point explanation of how you have addressed each reviewers' and editors' comments.

As the EIC in charge, I have read your paper twice over the last two days. While I am somewhat familiar with the area (especially the first three references, plus a bit of the fourth one), I will admit that I could barely follow the flow of ideas in your paper. Unlike regular submissions or other pearl submissions, your paper jumps right into the middle of a topic, using difficult to understand notation, and giving only the barest of context. I expect that an EIC with my background should be able to follow a paper in this area with much less effort...

Instead of assigning your paper to a Managing Editor, I am therefore taking the liberty to reject your submission immediately. I urge you to read some of the recent theoretical publications in Journal and to compare/contrast with your own submission.




